2019 Letter to the Chorus from the OCC Board

Thank you for your dedication to the Orrville Community Chorus! We are glad you have chosen to sing with us this year. Your enthusiastic commitment to our rehearsals and performance of Handel's "Messiah" demonstrates the importance of this masterpiece in your life.

Orrville Community Chorus, Inc. operates on an annual budget of more than \$11,000 to present Handel's "Messiah". Major expenses include venue rental, riser rental, printing costs, and musicians' fees.

OCC also sponsors the Victor Gerber Memorial Music Scholarship, which is awarded to outstanding Wayne County high school seniors who are actively involved in music and plan to continue their music involvement in college. The 2019 recipient was Savannah Johns, a graduate of Orrville High School. She was awarded a \$1000 scholarship. The number of scholarships awarded annually is determined by funds available and applicant merit. As of 2019, OCC has awarded \$35,000 in scholarships since 2003.

Beginning in 2019 it is necessary to establish a dues requirement for all chorus members. The dues will be \$25 for adults and \$15 for students. The dues are separate from donations. If you have any questions, please email the address provided on the Chorus page.

In addition to your vocal support and dues, donations are always welcome to assist the chorus in meeting the expenses of our annual performance and scholarship awards. Orrville Community Chorus, Inc. is a non-profit charitable corporation, so donations are tax deductible. A Board member will be available at the sign in table at every rehearsal to accept dues and donations. A receipt for donations will be provided to each identified donor. Chorus members and others who donate at least \$25 no later than the November 24^h rehearsal will have their names listed in the program unless anonymity is requested. In addition, each donor of \$100 or more will receive two passes to the December 8, 2019 performance.
